



Code of Conduct for Administrators and Volunteers for the Ohio Area 2 Envirothon

This Ohio Area 2 Envirothon Code of Conduct policy is to promote the safety of minors involved in the Ohio Area 2 Envirothon Competition. While team advisors from each school or team are directly responsible for student participants, Envirothon competition administrators and volunteers are an important component of the program and will be expected to uphold the code of conduct outlined below.

Please review and sign:

As an administrator or volunteer of the Ohio Area 2 Envirothon Program I will adhere to the following code of conduct:

- Accept the responsibility to professionally represent the Envirothon program as well as the Ohio Federation of Soil and Water Conservation Districts.
- Conduct myself in a respectful manner, including not cursing or telling inappropriate jokes, sharing details of one's personal life, or using tobacco, alcohol or any illegal substances.
- I will not be alone or one-on-one with a minor participant/student at anytime; nor at anytime be in sleeping quarters of any student participant unless addressing an issue and accompanied by another chaperone.
- I will not use my smartphone to video or take pictures of any students unless approved by the Envirothon administrators.
- I will refrain from engaging in any criminal conduct.
- I will help to ensure the Envirothon program is a positive and safe environment for all participants
