The *Stormwater Specialist* provides technical assistance and support on urban conservation, natural resources, urban stream, and stormwater management initiatives.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans (SWP3) and conduct inspections of construction sites for compliance with County and local regulations
- Coordinate escalation of enforcement or “Notice of Violation” procedures with the County Prosecutor or local community
- Assist with development and maintenance of the stormwater control measures (SCM) inventory
- Assist the communities with their Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) programs

Qualifications:

- A bachelor’s degree in conservation, natural resources, environmental science, construction science or other science related field, or a combination of education and work-related experience.
- Ability to read and write instructions, correspondence and memos; ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations.
- Knowledge and proficiency in using MS Office products (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Publisher and Access).
- The ability to pass a drug test and background check.
- Valid driver’s license and good driving record.
